By car

Enter Crystal Palace park from Anerley Hill. Take the first right and at the mini roundabout go straight ahead through the width restriction bollards. This leads to the road behind the Jubilee Stand, the athletics track will be on your left. Follow signs to the Jubilee Stand where there is dedicated clinic parking. Alternatively if you can't go through the barriers (they're over 2.35m wide) follow signs to the sports centre where there is more parking and then walk back across the bridge to the Jubilee Stand.



By rail

Crystal Palace rail station is a short 5 minute walk from the clinic. Turn right out of the station and make your way into the park. Turn right down the circuit road and follow signs to the Jubilee Stand. You can also walk from Penge East or Penge West Stations. From the High Street enter the park at the Thicket Road entrance and follow the path straight all the way to a gate in the fence underneath some steps. Turn left and you'll arrive at the Jubilee Stand.



By bus

Crystal Palace has a main bus terminus at the top of the hill. It is a 15 minute walk to the Centre and is serviced by numerous bus routes including the 3, 122, 157, 202, 227, 249, 322, 358, 363, 410, 417, 432, 450, 931



By underground

Crystal Palace Overground arrives at the British Rail Station and the directions are the same as above.
